

Terms and Conditions

The Times/Vintage Classics/RHCB Wind in the Willows illustration competition

1. T&Cs - By entering this competition you agree to accept and be bound by these terms and conditions.
2. The Promoter – The promoter is Vintage Classics, an imprint of The Random House Group Limited (**'promoter'**).
3. Entrants - This competition is open to anyone aged 7 to 12 years old who is a resident of the UK or the Republic of Ireland, except for employees of Vintage Classics, and Random House Children's Books, divisions of The Random House Group Limited, Times Newspapers Limited ("The Times"), their families and any other company connected with the competition. The promoter will only accept 1 entry per entrant.
4. Dates – Entries will be accepted from Monday 26th May 2008 until the closing date of Friday 25th July 2008 (**'closing date'**). The winning entrant and runners-up will be notified by telephone in the week beginning 6th October. The name of the winning entrant and runners-up will be printed in The Times on 1st November.
5. Prizes -
 - (a) The winning entrant will have their illustration featured on the jacket of the Vintage Classics edition of The Wind in the Willows, which is due to be published on 6th November 2008, as well as 40 Random House Children's Books of their choice, and 10 copies of the Vintage Classics edition of The Wind in the Willows which will include their winning illustration (**'First Prize'**);
 - (b) The three runners-up will each receive 20 Random House Children's Books of their choice (**'Second Prize'**).Any enquiries relating to the First Prize and/or Second Prize should be emailed to windinthewillows@randomhouse.co.uk
5. Entry Specifications – Eligible entrants must create an original illustration inspired by The Wind in the Willows for use on the Vintage Classics edition of the book (**'entry'**). Entries can be in black and white or colour and must be submitted on no larger than A4 sized sheet to the address below. Entrants are advised to retain a copy of entries. Entries cannot be acknowledged or returned.
6. Unacceptable Entries -
 - (a) Entries which include any wording or text such as the title 'The Wind in the Willows', or the name of the author Kenneth Grahame or the name of the entrant;
 - (b) Entries which are submitted electronically, for example by email; and
 - (c) Entries which are received after the closing date;will not be accepted.
7. Each entrant confirms that their entry will not infringe any law or regulation or third party right, including but not limited to the law of copyright or trade marks.
8. Lost Entries - The promoter will not be responsible for delayed, undelivered or lost entries.
9. Copyright / Adaptation by the promoter – Entrants will own and retain any copyright in their entries. Entrants accept that the promoter reserves the right to adapt entries, including the winning and runners-up entries.
10. Judges - The competition will be judged by 5 judges who will look for original talent and seek to identify an illustration by a young artist that reflects the story of The Wind in the Willows. The judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into in relation to their decisions or the competition.
11. Winning Entrant - The winning entrant and runners-up agree to grant on a worldwide, royalty free perpetual basis to The Times and the promoter any necessary and relevant permissions relating to the publication of their entry in any media by the promoter and/or The Times. The winning entrant and runners-up agree to the use by the promoter and the Times of his/her name and photograph in relation to publicity material.
12. Data - Personal data will only be retained and used by the promoter for the purposes of this competition and will be deleted thereafter. Personal data will not be passed on to any third party.
